The Afghanistan Cricket Board hereby invites proposals from reputed Marketing Agencies and Media Houses for acquiring the Camera Production and Global Media Rights for the upcoming Afghanistan vs. Bangladesh Home Series 2025.

This bilateral series will be a high-profile cricketing event, given the strong rivalry and fan interest between the two nations. ACB offers a unique business opportunity to associate with the Afghan National Team during this prominent series.



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MEDIA AND CAMERA PRODUCTION RIGHTS

✓ Venue Details:

Based on the long-term MoU (2022–2027) signed between ACB and the Emirates Cricket Board (ECB) in November 2022, ACB has access to world-class cricket venues across the UAE for all its designated home series.

1. Global Media Rights:

ACB invites offers for global broadcast and digital distribution, with the following territorial exclusions:

India:

Digital/OTT rights in the Indian territory are protected.

Broadcast (TV) rights for India are available: Inclusion of a credible Indian television broadcaster is a mandatory component of this rights package. All RFP participants must clearly identify and confirm their proposed Indian TV broadcast partner within their proposal submission.



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MEDIA AND CAMERA PRODUCTION RIGHTS

- **♂** Bangladesh:
- All media rights in Bangladesh are protected under ACB's existing agreement.

 Afghanistan:
- Mobile App streaming rights within the territory of Afghanistan are held by the Etisalat app.
- ✓ ACB YouTube non-exclive global OTT (excluding the aforementioned territories)



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ADDITIONAL OBLIGATIONS & DELIVERY REQUIREMENTS

- ${\mathscr C}$ The successful media rights partner must:
 - Distribute the Live Feed via satellite to major broadcasters in designated territories, ensuring international-quality delivery.
- Configure and integrate the feed with approved digital/streaming platforms in eligible regions.
- ✓ Provide a free live feed to ACB's official social media platform (YouTube) for commercial viewership purposes only.
- ✓ Ensure any commercial monetization of broadcast or digital assets is pre-approved by ACB.
- ${\mathscr G}$ Present and commit to a minimum global broadcast spectrum.
- ${\mathscr C}\,$ Adhere to the minimum feed requirements of ACB partners and ACB youtube



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PROPOSED MINIMUM POOL OF COMMENTATORS

- ✓ One (1) Afghanistan cricket specialist Commentator nominated by the ACB
- ✓ One (1) participating team cricket specialist Commentator
- ✓ One (1) Presenter

Commentary may be required in multiple languages depending on market demands, subject to mutual agreement.


The Media Rights partner will be responsible for delivering a complete, high-quality live production setup, including:

- Minimum 20-camera setup including ICC-standard DRS system (e.g., Hawk-Eye or equivalent)
- ✓ ICC-standard DRS system (e.g., Hawk-Eye or equivalent)
- ✓ Full HD production (minimum 1080p)
- ✓ Super slow-motion replay capability
- ✓ Clean and dirty feed delivery
- ✓ Experienced crew: producers, directors, engineers, camera operators, audio team, replay and graphics operators
- ✓ Delivery of real time performance excerpts to ACB
- ✓ Delivery of full match extended highlights immediately after match conclusion
